



Minnesota

Minnesota does not license massage or Structural Integration at the state level. The Alliance for Licensing Massage Therapists has submitted legislation in order to change this (in 2016). Their bill would provide MTs statewide voluntary certification. ALMT wrote no exemption language into the bill. In the meantime, and perhaps even afterward, there are local government entities that do require massage to be licensed, so check with city and county governments to see what laws and regulations might apply to your practice. You could engage your local government and educating them as to appropriate regulation of SI (including exemption), building a standard within the state.
